WIN 8 “Upgrade” fails on Ee-PC

- ▶ Tried running an upgrade to existing Windows XP E-Book (Acer Aspire One D260).
- ▶ No CD player in E-Book so made “Bootable” USB Drive
- ▶ Booted from USB Drive, Upgrade ran for about an hour !!!
- ▶ Re-booted after upgrade – Windows ran then said “Your Screen resolution is too low to run Win 8” !!! Stopped !!!
- ▶ If so – why didn’t it stop at first hurdle? More research needed.
- ▶ Answer = Clean install on new Hard Drive.
- ▶ Upgraded Hard Drive to SSD and added extra RAM

How to get Win 8 to run on Ebook 1080 x 600 screen and then get Win 8 apps to open

Download latest Win 7 Driver for Graphics card (usually Intel).

Update registry to set "Display1_DownScalingSupported" to = 1
